

GENERAL INFORMATION

In the framework of the International Program for Advanced Training (IPTA) : "Climate Change, Mitigation and Adaptation" of the Swedish Meteorological and Hydrological Institute (SMHI) and funded by the Swedish International Development Cooperation Agency (Sida), **the Competence Centre of the West African Science Centre on Climate Change and Adapted Land Use (WASCAL- Coc)** will co-organize with SMHI a training session **from 10th to 18th February 2021** in Ouagadougou for the benefit of professionals from three beneficiary countries of the said program. In order to ensure the success of this event and in view of the health context, participants are informed that the following general arrangements will be made in accordance with those of the Ministry of Health of Burkina Faso (<https://www.sante.gov.bf/corona-virus>) during their travels and stays at the Competence Center:

- 1- Each participant must have a document attesting to a negative PCR test result dating no more than five days before entering the territory. This test will be re-checked once in Burkina Faso;**
- 2- Each participant will be asked to strictly respect the social distance of at least 1 m from his neighbor during the sessions in the room and in the Competence Center;**
- 3- Wearing a mask is mandatory for all members in the room;**
- 4- Hand washing with hydroalcoholic gel at the entrance and exit of the rooms is mandatory.**
